The disappearance of 43 students and the confirmed torture and assassination of 3 of them from a very poor rural public school (near Acapulco), exactly one month ago, ordered by the corrupt mayor (now fugitive) that is linked to drug trafficking. (See attached article in *The New Yorker*)

While *Time Magazine* lied to the American public reporting that the Mexican President Peña Nieto is the "savior of Mexico," the situation in Mexico cannot be worse and the politicians themselves are the ones who are involved in corruption and organized crime, and causing an abysmal income inequality.

What does that have to do with US people, specifically in NYC?

Many of the Mexican workers who you see working in New York delis, restaurants and other services are fleeing the organized crime, and all of them are escaping from a tremendous poverty caused by the policies of social inequality imposed by Wall Street and the World Bank. 11 million Mexican immigrants live and work in the US due to an economic system that creates the richest man in the world (Carlos Slim) at the expense of millions of poor people

How can you help?

DO NOT PLAN YOUR VACATION IN MEXICO, NO MATTER HOW CHEAP, BUT ALSO LET THE MINISTRY OF TOURISM KNOW WHY. WRITE A LETTER to the Minister of Tourism of Mexico and tell her you're not going to travel to Mexico until the crimes of the 43 students are clarified in Guerrero.
