JOB OPENING: Broadcast Engineer

SUMMARY OF POSITION

Radio Bilingüe is seeking an entry-level Broadcasting Engineer to provide technical support to its network stations. This Engineer will assist our Chief Engineer in installing and maintaining broadcast equipment, including radio production (analog/digital audio), FM transmitters, microwave, satellite antenna and receivers, IP codec and other equipment.

DUTIES

- Support the day-to-day operations of Radio Bilingüe radio broadcasting, including daily radio production operations, FM radio transmitter operations and maintenance, emergency backup power generators and other broadcast equipment as well as computer-based IT systems.
- Install, maintain and repair satellite receivers, digital/analog audio mixing console, other audio equipment, routers, automation systems (ENCO), audio editing systems, IP codec, web streaming servers, computers, Studio Transmitter Link (STL), broadcasting antenna (STL and transmission antenna) and radio towers.
- Consult and communicate with engineering management and consulting engineers on technical issues as needed.
- Conduct light building maintenance.
- Perform light administrative tasks.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Bachelor's degree in electronics or electrical engineering or 3-5 years of equivalent experience
- Ability to work weekend and/or evenings as needed
- Ability to travel long distances to help manage multiple broadcast sites
- Ability to lift heavy equipment (up to 50 lbs.)
- Ability to occasionally climb towers for antennas and cables maintenance work
- Valid driving license

COMPENSATION

The pay range for this position is \$55,000 to \$60,000 annually. This is a regular, full-time position that requires flexible scheduling, including some work during weekends and evenings. Radio Bilingüe's comprehensive benefits package includes vacation and sick leave, health, dental, and life insurance; a retirement plan; a supportive team culture and support for professional development activities.
